Dear Friends,

"Have this mind among yourselves, which was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death. even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

This passage from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians is known as the Philippians Hymn. It is prayed every Saturday evening in the Breviary. It was probably a hymn sung by the early Christians, and part of it is also used as the Gospel acclamation on Good Friday.

It is a beautiful exhortation to self-sacrifice and humble service lived by Jesus and encouraged for all Christians. Why do our knees bow before Jesus? Because of the salvation he won for us by his humility in taking up the Cross and offering His life out of love.

St. Therese of Lisieux, also known as the Little Flower, whose feast day is today, lived a life of sacrifice for others during her short life. "I prefer the monotony of obscure sacrifice to all ecstasies. To pick up a pin for love can convert a soul," she wrote. Vocation means the way that God is calling an individual to love. Marriage, consecrated religious or single life, priesthood and diaconate – all these are ways to answer God's call to love.

This weekend, our parishioner Michael Frankiewicz, who is in First Theology at Mundelein Seminary, will speak at the Masses, sharing his vocation story with us, and asking for our support. Please keep all seminarians and all those discerning vocations in your prayers.



St. Francis Inspired the Encyclical Laudato si

Pope Francis' Message

When we can see God reflected in all that exists, our hearts are moved to praise the Lord for all his creatures and to worship him in union with them. This sentiment is reflected in Pope Francis' encyclical *Laudato si'* (Praise be to You). Here is a quotation from that document:

"...Saint Francis, faithful to Scripture, invites us to see nature as a magnificent book in which God speaks to us and grants us a glimpse of his infinite beauty and goodness. Francis was particularly concerned for God's creation and for the poor and outcast...He was a mystic and a pilgrim who lived in simplicity and...harmony with God, with others, with nature and with himself. He shows us just how inseparable the bond is between concern for nature, justice for the poor, commitment to society, and interior peace. If we approach nature and the environment without this openness to awe and wonder...our attitude will be that of masters, consumers, ruthless exploiters, unable to set limits on their immediate needs. By contrast, if we feel intimately united with all that exists, then sobriety and care will well up spontaneously. The poverty and austerity of Saint Francis were no mere veneer of asceticism, but something much more radical: a refusal to turn reality into an object simply to be used and controlled."

The St. James Earth Shepherds Ministry

Established in 2015, their mission is simple: to provide education, prayer and opportunities for action so that we may be faithful stewards of God's creation, breathing life into the message of *Laudato si*! A few ministry activities have been:

- Loaning dishes and serveware to anyone at no cost, decreasing the use of disposable products.
- Sending monthly emails to interested parishioners with action items that take less than one minute to complete.
- · Hosting films, providing rain barrels and more.

Many people of all ages came together throughout the past eight years to sow and care for a native, *Laudato si'* garden at the school parking lot. Please visit the prayer patio in the garden anytime. A bench crafted from 100+ year-old reclaimed bowling alley wood will be installed there soon.





Feed the Hungry - Loaves & Fishes Ministry

For over thirty years, the St. James community has reached out to the homeless in Chicago's Uptown neighborhood. The Loaves & Fishes Ministry provides an evening meal and a brown bag lunch for women at Sarah's Circle. Our ministry operates every Saturday beginning in October and continues through the last weekend in April.

We previously supported the NS Housing men's shelter. Unfortunately, this shelter has temporarily moved to the Midway Airport area. With regret, we are unable to provide support until its return to the Uptown neighborhood. Further information will follow once we receive notification.

Numerous St. James groups prepare lunches and meals, and many families and individuals make lunches, pick up soup and bread and give up their Saturday evenings to deliver food to the shelters. Thanks to all who have helped in the past.

- Pick up soup from local restaurants on Saturday afternoon
- Make approximately 50 lunches

- Shift Volunteers work one Wednesday per month covering four-hour or five-hour shifts from 7:00 pm -7:00 am. Shift Volunteers must be 18 or older, or 16 with a parent. 2nd & 3rd shift volunteers are especially needed.
- Food Teams provide and/or serve warm dinner for the guests one Wednesday per month.
- Clean-Up Volunteers work Thursday mornings 6:30-7:30 am.

There will be additional opportunities for small groups, scouts, youth groups, community groups, teams, ministries, etc.




