# A MESSAGE FROM...

## Today's Readings

Dear Friends,

Isaiah chapter 5 is called the Cantic of the Vineyard. Jesus repeats this passage in the Gospel today. In the Book of Isaiah, God destroys the vineyard because of the failure of the owner of the vineyard to care for his vineyard.

Jesus refers to the vineyard, which is the Church! What are we doing to cultivate and feed the vineyard? Jesus founded the Church as the vehicle through which the Good News (Gospel) of the Lord will be proclaimed to the whole world.

What is the mission of the Church? Is it to create a better physical world through solving the various challenges of the day? Or is it to bring the Good News of salvation to every person and circumstance in our world? In the Great Commission at the end of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus commissions, or charges, the Apostles to go to all the world and teach and baptize, and proclaim His Good News of salvation to all.

We also have a responsibility and

vocation to love...to regard the needs of others as greater than our own. This does include caring for the gifts that have been given to us – in nature and in our material goods, entrusted to us by God's Providence.

One of the important ways we do this is through our loving support of many initiatives of mercy and justice in our community and beyond through Jubilation, our annual fundraising event which generously supports many apostolates and outreaches to those who need our financial help. Please prayerfully consider attending Jubilation, which will take place on November 4 at the Lincolnshire Marriott (see page 4 for information). ### *Over-the-Top Mercy: Today's Gospel*

Jesus' parables are much stranger than most people realize. This week is an attention-getting example. He tells the religious leaders a parable about a completely absurd situation. Blood-thirsty and insane tenants violently abuse and kill the servants of their land-lord. Inexplicably, the owner keeps sending them more victims of increasing value — up to and including his own son. Weird.

Usually, we hear this parable and assume it's an allegory: Jesus is the murdered son, the servants the prophets, etc. Fair enough. But notice — and here is where the weirdness deepens — Jesus seems to disagree with the Pharisees' interpretation that the landowner should and will punish the inheritance-obsessed murderers. So, is Jesus praising the psychotic and greedy murderers?! You can imagine the furrowed brows and deriding laughter as the scoffing crowd shuffles away.

If we stay with this tough parable, perhaps this truth emerges: God wants us to have an over-the-top obsession with a totally undeserved inheritance. Of course, we are forbidden to use violence. But the parable's violence gets our attention because it highlights the crazy goodness of the landowner. Jesus reveals that God is not merely in the business of rewarding the good and punishing the bad. He is playing a much stranger game — one marked by a kind of over-the-top mercy, a breathtaking giving of what is not deserved. What would our week look like if we embraced this kind of desire for God's kingdom on earth, even if others think we're nuts? This week let's seek God's kingdom with a passionate confidence in God's desire to give the good things we don't deserve.

## Feed the Hungry - Loaves & Fishes Ministry

For over thirty years, the St. James community has reached out to the homeless in Chicago's Uptown neighborhood. The Loaves & Fishes Ministry provides an evening meal and a brown bag lunch for women at Sarah's Circle. Our ministry operates every Saturday beginning in October and continues through the last weekend in April.

We previously supported the NS Housing men's shelter. Unfortunately, this shelter has temporarily moved to the Midway Airport area. With regret, we are unable to provide support until its return to the Uptown neighborhood. Further information will follow once we receive notification.

Numerous St. James groups prepare lunches and meals, and many families and individuals make lunches, pick up soup and bread and give up their Saturday evenings to deliver food to the shelters. Thanks to all who have helped in the past.

- Make approximately 50 lunches
