#### **First Reading**

You have turned aside from the way, and have caused many to falter by your instruction. (Mal 2:8)

With such affection for you, we were determined to share with you not only the gospel of God, but our very selves as well, so dearly beloved had you become to us. (1Thes 2:8)

#### **Gospel:**

"Therefore, do and observe all things whatsoever they tell you, but do not follow their example. For they preach but they do not practice." (Mt 23:3)



"Paul reminds us to be faithful to God's word."

Dear Friends,

Our second reading today presents St. Paul's words of affection to the Thessalonians, one of the early churches which he founded in the city of Thessaloniki, in northern Greece on the shores of the Aegean Sea. A mere twenty or so years after the Resurrection, Paul has faithfully preached the Gospel around the eastern end of the Mediterranean Sea.

Paul reminds the Thessalonians that word he has preached to them is not his own: "[I]n receiving the word of God from hearing us, you received not a human word but, as it truly is, the word of God, which is now at work in you who believe" (1 Thes 2:13).

Two things stand out: the necessity of faithfulness to God's inspired word, and the assurance that God's word, faithfully preached and received, works in us who believe. There is sometimes a temptation to read God's word selectively, perhaps to make myself more comfortable with challenging teachings. Paul is reminding us to be faithful to God's word, to allow it to work in us and on us, to trust that God has our good in mind.

Jesus reminds us in the Gospel that God is the first teacher, master, and father. He is Truth, and desires that all men be saved and "come unto the knowledge of the truth" (1 Tim 2:4).

We kindly ask that you keep our men and women of the armed forces in your prayers always.


Veterans will be recognized at 7:30 am Mass on Saturday, November 11 here at St. James. We will remember family members who were killed in action as well as current military.
