



Dear Friends,

In the parable of the talents in Matthew 25, we hear the familiar story of the talents given to the master's servants, and their stewardship of those talents. Some did better than others in caring for and using the resources they were given. This weekend we are presenting our financial report for the last fiscal year. Along with that report, I would also like to call attention to the trend in mass attendance over the last year in particular, and also the longerterm trend.

First, the good news. Our weekly Sunday mass attendance has reached a 20-year high. Numbers are skewed somewhat due the COVID effect, but over the past years, our attendance increased substantially, from a low of around 2400 in 2012 to 3000 in 2023. This represents an increase of roughly 25% over the decade. This is very hopeful news! These figures are based on the annual October counts which each parish reports every year. We also do a monthly count to be aware of the trends.

Second, the challenge. As you can see from the accompanying financial report, income is lagging somewhat, and expenses have increased, both in the school and on the parish side. We have, however, remained in the black. Some of the increased costs are detailed in the notes to the financial report.

As for lagging income, there are a couple of considerations. First, demographic change. While it is difficult to quantify at the moment, we have seen a noticeable increase in young families at Sunday mass. Understandably, this cohort, raising young children, have many expenses which may limit the ability to give as much as older, more established families or couples whose expenses are different.

Many of these long-time, generous parishioners have moved away from St. James, living in retirement communities, or have passed away. Second, the economy. We are all painfully aware of how high inflation is eating away at our buying power. Just going to the grocery store is a painful reminder of how the cost of living has increased.

Finally, thank you for your continued generosity to our St. James community. I ask you to prayerfully consider your stewardship of the resources the Lord has entrusted to you, and to continue your generous support.
