A MESSAGE FROM...

Today's Readings

First Reading:

A voice cries out: In the desert prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God! (Is 40:3)

Psalm:

Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation. (Ps 85)

Second Reading:

We await new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. (1 Pt 1:13)

Gospel:

John the Baptist appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. (Mk 16:4)



"I encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to make a fresh start."

Dear Friends,

"The Lord does not delay his promise, as some regard "delay," but he is patient with you, not wishing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9).

Peter reminds us of the important meaning of this time of repentance and preparation, the season of Advent; firstly, the Lord's desire for us, and secondly, our interior disposition as we prepare.

The Prophet Isaiah, in the first reading, uses earthy language which can be applied to our own hearts: "In the desert prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God! Every valley shall be filled in, every mountain and hill shall be made low; the rugged land shall be made a plain, the rough country, a broad valley." (Isaiah 40:3).

Multi-parish Penance Services will be offered this week at the area parishes. All the priests of these parishes will

be available at each location to hear confessions. Please see the schedule in this bulletin on the next page.

There is a necessary humility in confessing our sins in the sacrament, but a powerful grace that comes in a good confession. I encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to make a fresh start and receive the Lord's abundant forgiveness.

There's a scene in John Powers' delightful novel about growing up Catholic in the 1950s *Do Black Patent Leather Shoes Really Reflect Up?* in which the author leaves church and returns home after going to confession. In his head he hears these joyful words – Free from sin! Free from sin! Free from sin!

Advent TAIZE

As we await the birth of Christ, the Light of Hope, let our voices be a light for all as we pray through our singing.

Taize worship is prayer consisting of meditative singing and periods of silence in order to reach a contemplative state.

PATH TO SUNDAY



Our gospel reading for today is curious in that it begins: "the beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God." It then continues to reference the prophecy of Isaiah (Isaiah 40:1-5) regarding the coming of the messiah (Jesus) to be announced by his forerunner (John the Baptist).

Why does St. Mark start by writing, "The beginning of the gospel..."? Can you imagine Dickens starting *A Christmas Carol* by writing, "The beginning of the Christmas Carol of Charles Dickens?"

When St. Mark writes "the beginning," it isn't because he lacks creativity and should have written "once upon a time." To understand, it helps to know that the word "gospel" is from the Greek New Testament text as εὐαγγέλιον (euangelion); it means "good news." Jesus himself is the good news; he is the savior. St. Mark tells Jesus' story. Add to this, the phrase "The beginning" recalls Genesis, the first words of which are, "In the beginning" (from the Hebrew word b'reshit). It is in the first chapters of Genesis that we hear about Original Sin and humanity's need for salvation. Thus, the gospel is, in a sense, the answer to Genesis.

We see in the prophet Isaiah, an expectation of the messiah, the Hebrew mashiach or "anointed one." This word is rendered into Greek as christos (Χρίστος). Christ is not Jesus' last name; Jesus did not have a last name. "Christ" is a title, as in Jesus the Christ. While the Jewish people were expecting a messiah of the line of King David, they thought he would simply come to save Israel from the power of the pagan Roman Empire. They didn't expect that he would save the world from sin and death. They also didn't expect him to be God incarnate, the Son of God.
