This is the message of the angels announcing the birth of the Messiah, the anointed one, the savior sent to rescue us from the filth of sin and death.


He has come to save us, to offer us a new way of living, a new way of understanding our relationship with the God who sees us as beloved sons and daughters.




Can You Help the Homeless?






