A MESSAGE FROM...

Today's Readings

Dear Friends,

And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem. - Luke 2:38

The prophetess Anna, an 84-year-old widow, appears in Luke's account of the Presentation of the Lord today. We are told that, "she never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer." Anna was given the powerful grace of being one of the first people to see the Messiah, and to know that he was indeed the Messiah.

Anna is a beautiful example of an evangelical disciple. She comes to know the Lord, offers thanksgiving to God for the gift, and proclaims the Messiah to the people of Jerusalem, who had been awaiting him and his redemption.

We begin a new calendar year in the midst of our celebration of the coming of God into our world and into our race. Anna knew that everything was changed now forever. God had come to rescue his people and to bring them into a new relationship with the Father.

The Apostle John writes to fathers and

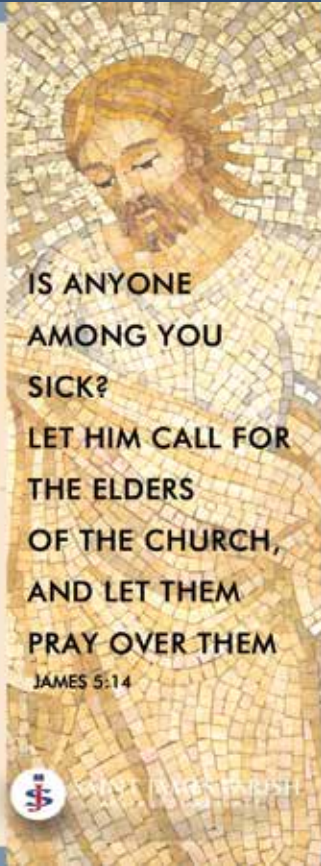
young men encouraging them not to love the things of the world – lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and pride of life – "because your sins have been forgiven for his name's sake, because you know him who is from the beginning, because you know the Father, because you are strong and the word of God remains in you, and you have conquered the Evil One." John writes that these things are not of God but are of the world, and this world and its attractions are passing away, while those who do God's will remain forever (1Jn 2:12-17).

New Year's resolutions often characterize this holiday. What a great time for a different kind of resolution – to fully embrace our life in Christ and to reject the empty lies of the world.



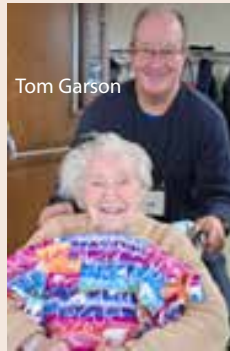
