

Dear Friends.

Tomorrow, January 22, is the 51st anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision by the U.S. Supreme Court striking down state laws outlawing abortion. On June 24, 2022, in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, the U.S. Supreme Court overruled *Roe v. Wade*, and returned authority to regulate abortion to the states. Tragically, this has been followed by numerous states attempting to enshrine the right to abortion as a constitutional right.

Our state of Illinois is one of the most permissive in the U.S.A. promoting abortion. Last summer, Governor J.B. Pritzker, in announcing the proposed allocation of \$23 million to promote access to abortion, (including bussing women from out of state to abortion clinics in Illinois), euphemistically said, "Illinois will remain a safe haven for women."

The tragedy of the wholehearted support of this awful procedure is a painful reminder of the failure on the part of many elected officials and their constituents to make the moral choice to protect vulnerable and precious human life.

The Second Vatican Council taught clearly on abortion: "Life must be safeguarded with extreme care from conception; abortion and infanticide are abominable crimes," (*Gaudium et spes*, 51).

If Illinois is to, "remain a safe haven for women," we are morally bound to assist women in difficult pregnancies, to offer support as they raise their children, to understand their fear and to try to ease it.

As Catholics, we offer God's loving forgiveness through the sacrament of Confession to those women (and men) who deeply regret their choice, and desire peace.

Thank you to our dedicated and prayerful Respect Life Committee for consistent witness to the beauty and sacredness of human life. Let us pray that our state and our nation may become places which work to protect the gift of life.






