Dear Friends,

In the New Testament, it is reported that Jesus cast out demons fifty-five times. Today we have another incidence of it in Mark's Gospel: "they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and He drove out many demons." Mark 1:32

In past years, it was a reality that some in the Church considered the idea of demons or evil spirits to be a superstitious belief or a fairy tale. The whole idea of spiritual warfare was dismissed, perhaps because of a belief that we are too sophisticated to believe in such a thing. Sadly, I heard that often in my Catholic high school.

I am grateful that I trained


