In contrast to the treatment of lepers in today's first reading (Leviticus 13) Jesus offers wholeness and healing to the outcast in today's Gospel reading. "Be made clean." What powerful and beautiful words and actions. Jesus has restored the leper to communion with his people.

He has the same desire for us: communion both with God and with others. Notice, however, what preceded the healing: the leper came to Jesus, knelt down and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Before our Savior worked this miracle, the sick man had a prayerful encounter with Jesus in which he

opened his heart to the Lord.

As we begin Lent, may we open our hearts in prayer more and more to Him.

Our Parish Mission is a time to be together as a community while learning how to deepen our prayer and devotion. This year we have as our speaker Father Tim Oudenhoven of the Diocese of La Crosse, Wisconsin. He is an expert on the tilma miracle of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Plan to join us next week, Feb. 18-20 at 7:00 p.m. for this special event.
