

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT



Today's Readings

First Reading:

God said to Noah and to his sons with him: "See, I am now establishing my covenant with you and your descendants after you and with every living creature that was with you." (**Gn 9:8-10**)

Psalm:

Your ways, O Lord, are love and truth to those who keep your covenant. (Ps 25)

Second Reading:

It is not a removal of dirt from the body but an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. (1 Pt 3:21)

Gospel:

He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him. (Mk 1:13)



Dear Friends,

On Ash Wednesday we began our observance of the holy season of Lent, the forty days preceding the solemn feast of the Resurrection of the Lord, or Easter. Lent is one of the oldest liturgical and spiritual traditions of the Church. The Council of Nicaea in 325 A.D. called for the season to be fixed at forty days.

Classically, we observe three spiritual practices during Lent: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Increased prayer can open us up to a more intense encounter with the Lord. Fasting can remove those things which can block the grace of God from entering into our lives more fully. It is traditional to remove some material good, not because there's something evil about it, but because self-denial can clear the way for a more fruitful encounter with God. Almsgiving is sharing from our own goods to serve the poor.

There are several Lenten offerings at St. James, including an additional noon Mass Monday through Friday. Our Lenten mission begins this Sunday and

> continues through Tuesday evening. Fr. Tim Oudenhoven of the Diocese of LaCrosse, Wisconsin, who holds a doctorate in Theology specializing in Our Lady of Guadalupe and evangelization, will present on that topic.

Stations of the Cross will be held on Friday evenings. Once again St. James will be a part of multi-parish reconciliation services along with the other area parishes. I encourage you to receive this powerful sacrament of God's mercy before Easter.

Lent will culminate with the Easter Triduum – "three days" – of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. More than twenty people will be entering the Catholic Church here at the Easter Vigil. Please pray for them.

MINISTRY UPDATE

Did You Take the Quiz? Devon's Personal Story

As a teen, I was in a toxic relationship. Reflecting on last week's Healthy Relationship Quiz, I now see behaviors that should have raised red flags for me then. If I'd taken the quiz as a teen, I might have recognized unhealthy behaviors before matters worsened. Here are a few questions that could have prompted me to reconsider my relationship:

Question 4 "Understands that I have my own life too" – He tried to involve himself in everything. He memorized my class schedule down to the minute. If I failed to text him during my passing period, he grilled me.

Question 5 "Is not liked very well by my friends" – Once, my friend group was upset I was bringing him for pre-homecoming dance pictures. They didn't want him around. Other friends distanced themselves from me until we broke up. Listen to your friends. If more than one dislikes your partner, there may be a reason.


Question 8 "Thinks I spend too much time trying to looking nice" – He accused me of dressing cute so that other guys would notice me.

Question 10 "Accuses me of flirting or cheating" – Every conversation I had with another male led to accusations and interrogations that I was cheating on him.

Question 20 "Threatens to hurt me, my friends or family" – I finally decided to end things. I was riding in his car and he said to me – word for word – "I better get you out of this car before I hurt you." I felt in my core that he was capable of this. I ceased all communication, but he asked friends to deliver messages. When one refused, he texted her "I hope your school burns down with you inside." This solidified our belief that he was dangerous. We went to the police for help.

I encourage all teens (adults, too) to take the Healthy Relationship Quiz. Reflect on your relationship. Be honest with yourself. Don't ignore red flags. I was lucky to get out and escape the immediate danger. Others, though, may not be. Abuse doesn't always come in the form of a black eye, but every shiner began with a small, toxic comment.

Today I am married to a wonderful man and we are the proud parents of a beautiful baby boy. There are people out there who deserve your love. Don't sell yourself short.


