A MESSAGE FROM...

Today's Readings

First Reading:

In those days, God delivered all these commandments: "I, the LORD am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery. You shall not have other gods besides me."

(Ex 20:1-3)

Dear Friends,

We begin this third week of Lent with the dramatic account of Jesus cleansing the Temple in Jerusalem.

In a rare display of righteous anger, John writes, Jesus made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace."

The Temple was meant to be a place of access to God for all the people of Israel. Here they carried out their religious duties, offering sacrifice to God according to the Law. The moneychangers and the merchants selling the animals to be sacrificed were cheating the people.

Jesus' mission was to reveal the Father to the people of Israel, and ultimately to the whole world. Ultimately he

reconciled God and the human race through his loving act of self-sacrifice and his Resurrection. His anger at the corruption in the Temple was a righteous reaction to those who were impeding the people from their union with God.

This Lent, the Lord offers us yet again the invitation to communion. Through our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, may we open ourselves to this communion.

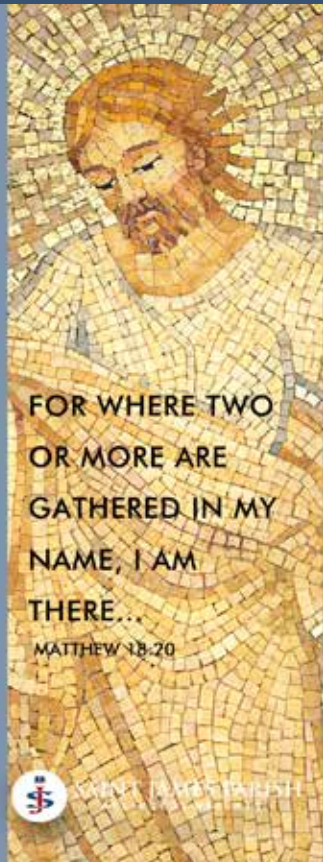

WOMEN AND FAITH

In 1995, John Paul II penned his *Letter of Pope John Paul II to Women*. Marking the occasion of the Fourth World Conference on Women, Pope John Paul expresses his appreciation to the UN for hosting the event, addressing his remarks to all women – considering the challenges they face in today’s world and their inherent dignity as children of God.

In his letter, Pope John Paul II offers his thanks to women in their roles – as mothers, wives, daughters, sisters, workers, religious, “educators,” and “nurses” – and acknowledges their accomplishments throughout history. He also acknowledges the obstacles they have faced – their dignity and worth having gone unrecognized and under-appreciated, having been blocked from reaching their full potential as God intended which “has resulted in a spiritual impoverishment of humanity.” “In all its expressions, womanhood is part of the essential heritage of mankind and of the Church herself.”

He speaks of Christ’s regard for and treatment of women – with reverence, acceptance, setting an example which countered the cultural norms of His day. Unfortunately, those customs and standards continue to shape beliefs about and actions towards women. Women have been disadvantaged, excluded, ignored, underestimated and many are esteemed purely for their physical attributes and not their talents and abilities, the essence of their being. The Pope speaks out against sexual exploitation and violence against them and addresses as well the “urgent need to achieve real equality in every area: equal pay for equal work, protection for working mothers, fairness in career advancements, equality of spouses with regard to family rights and the recognition of everything that is part of rights and duties of citizens in a democratic State.” He calls for change and appeals to humanity – “that women regain full respect for their dignity and role.”

In his weekly general audience on March 8, 2023, Pope Francis spoke in praise of women for the gifts they bring to the world and their contributions to building a more civilized society. Let us, too, celebrate their accomplishments, recognize the work yet to be done and reflect on God's vision for women in His "plan for humanity."
