

## Today's Readings

#### First Reading:

Early and often did the LORD, the God of their fathers, send his messengers to them, for he had compassion on his people and his dwelling place. But they mocked the messengers of God, despised his warnings, and scoffed at his prophets, until the anger of the LORD against his people was so inflamed that there was no remedy. (2 Chr 36:15-16)

Dear Friends,

When Christian Smith and his fellow researchers with the National Study of Youth and Religion at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill took a close look at the religious beliefs held by American teenagers, they found that the faith held and described by most came down to something the researchers identified as "Moralistic Therapeutic Deism." It consists of beliefs like these: \*

- "A god exists who created and ordered the world and watches over human life on earth."
- 2. "God wants people to be good, nice, and fair to each other,"
- 3. "The central goal of life is to be happy and to feel good about oneself."
- "God does not need to be particularly involved in one's life except when He is needed to resolve a problem."
- 5. "Good people go to heaven when they die."

Such a belief system seems also to be at work in great numbers of adults as well – including many Christians. It begs the question: What do we do with the words in the Gospel of John, Chapter 3: For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did

not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God

By faith and Baptism, we are offered the salvation won at a great cost by Jesus Christ, the Son of God. We profess that Jesus is the unique path to salvation and eternal life. By God's grace and our free will, we can choose to accept this priceless gift. But we can never attain it by "being nice."

This Sunday is Laetare (Rejoice) Sunday. We are halfway through this penitential season of fasting, prayer and almsgiving. We continue to prepare ourselves through turning away from sin and embracing the life of Christ for the solemn feast of our salvation: Easter, the Lord's Resurrection.




