

Dear Friends,

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent, we are drawn ever closer to the events of Holy Week: the Last Supper and the institution of the sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Holy Orders, the arrest of Jesus, and His trial and humiliation and torture, and finally, His execution as a criminal on the Cross.

In John's Gospel, we are told what all of this means. It is the time of judgment on the world. This world deserves condemnation. The deceiver, the lord of this world, Satan, will be expelled. But when Jesus is raised from the dead, He will draw all people to Himself. He will never force anyone to come to Him, out of respect for our free will, but He has a deep desire for communion with each one of us.

Although this world deserves condemnation, God offers a remedy. Through Jesus, His only begotten, loved Son, He pays the price, and returns us to right relationship with Him.

We are approaching Easter, the greatest feast of the Church. Please receive the sacrament of Confession before Easter. Receive the healing and forgiveness which the Lord wants for you, that you may receive Holy Communion at Easter, and be one with Him.


