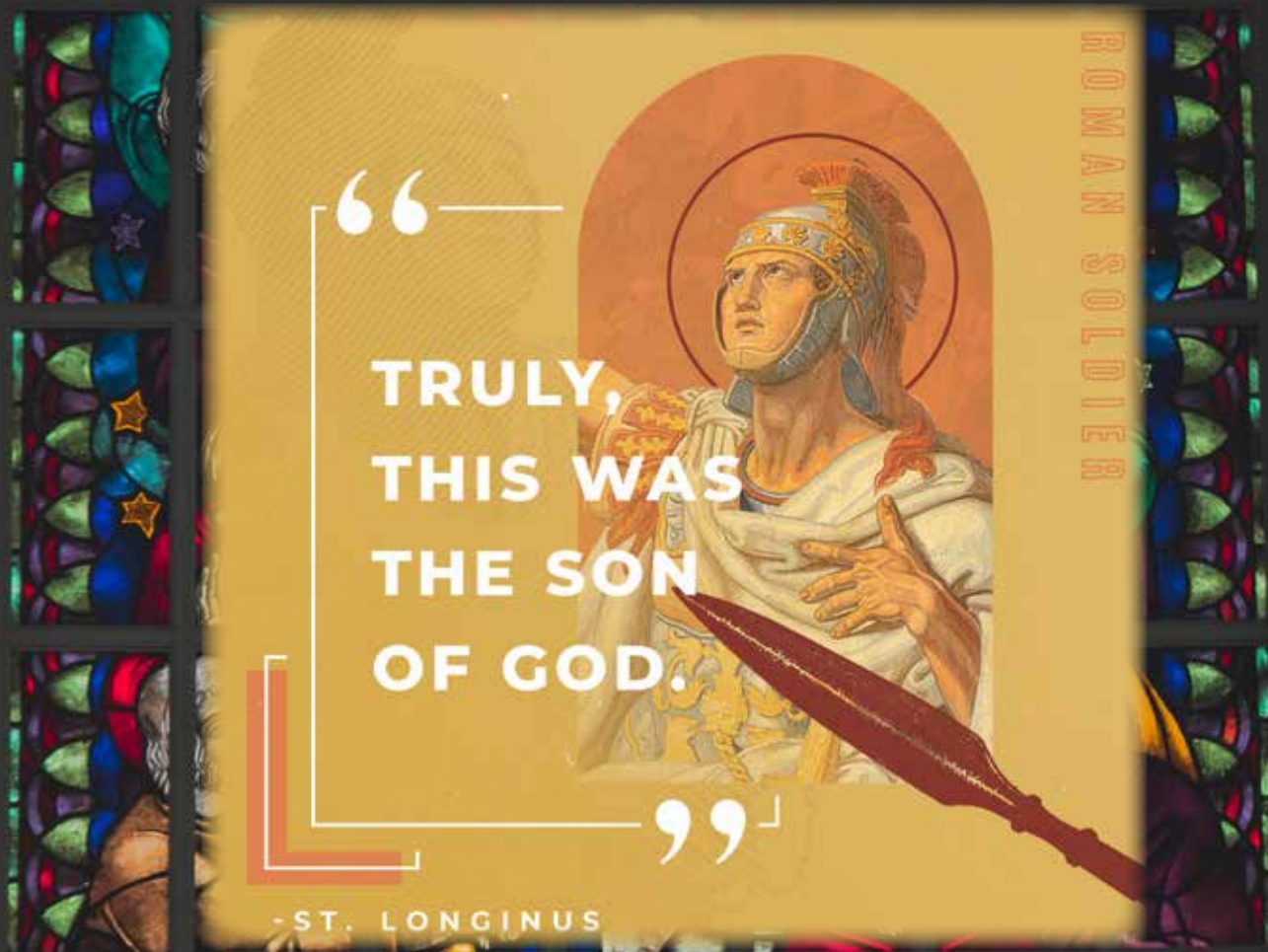

A MESSAGE FROM...

Today's Readings

Dear Friends,

Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. - Philippians 2:6-7

St. Paul, in his letter to the Philippians, chapter 2, presents the "Philippians Hymn." This scripture is a moving description of Jesus' humility in willingly sacrificing his own life out of great love. The concept of "emptying" (in Greek: kenosis) is understood as Jesus willingly laying aside his divine power. Dr. David Campbell wrote, "Jesus, the god-man, was fully divine, but veiled his glory to accomplish his mission – and prove humans could fulfill the Law of God with the help of the Holy Spirit and a commitment to faithfulness."

This is the mystery we walk through this Holy Week, beginning with the reading of the Passion today. Meditating on the sorrowful mysteries of the Rosary – the

Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane, the Scourging at the Pillar, the Crowning with Thorns, the Carrying of the Cross, and the Crucifixion – can help us to be united with Jesus as he endures his Passion.

But his seemingly humiliating death is not the end. The Philippians Hymn concludes with: *Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. - Philippians 2:8-11*

The one who was brutally executed has conquered death itself in his glorious Resurrection.

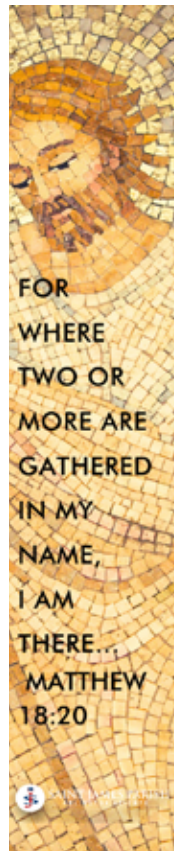
