Dear Friends,

In Acts Peter's bold claim, "There is no salvation through anyone else, nor is there any other name under heaven given to the human race by which we are to be saved," particularly in today's climate of indifferentism (the belief that differences of religious belief are of no importance), could be seen as arrogant and exclusive. The Apostle's claim is exclusive; it says that Jesus has something precious and unique to offer those who follow Him.

In fact, we know that Jesus Himself told His Apostles, "I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me," (John 14:6).

Other world religions do not have

the understanding of salvation which Christ revealed to us. They reject the notion of, "divine filiation," or becoming sons and daughters of God which is a scandal to them. In the second reading we hear, "See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are."

These passages of Sacred Scripture reveal to us God's desire for a communion of life and love with His creatures. Our God Jesus went to His death for this. His Resurrection, which we celebrate in a glorious way during these fifty days of the Easter season, conquered death and gives us hope – hope that we will share His life eternally if we live for Him, and receive Baptism and the Holy Spirit. After that we must go into the world and proclaim this Truth to everyone.
