

This is a great joy for us as a parish, to see the Lord working through us to bear great fruit.







That They Might Have Life

Abortion – Why Not? Even in the Hard Cases No Exceptions – Life is Sacred

Fetal Abnormality/Disability
The baby has no less of a right to live

(about 1 of 169 abortions)

Even if death is imminent, love and hold them

Life/Health of Mother (about 1 of 43 abortions) The necessity to abort to save a mother's life is so rare as to be nonexistent

Premature delivery or C-section is safer and much faster than surgical abortion

If both lives cannot be saved, the baby's life may be indirectly ended, as in treatment for an ectopic pregnancy or chemotherapy due to the principle of double effect

Rape or Incest

The child, like the mother, is an innocent victim and is worthy of life

(about 1 of 769 abortions)

4 Abortion is another level of violence and further psychologically harms the woman

God has a purpose for the baby

Total - 1 of every 33 abortions

God's wisdom is perfect – true compassion for mother and child


