A MESSAGE FROM...

Today's Readings

First Reading:

"This is why you must now know, and fix in your heart, that the LORD is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other."

(Dt 4:39)

Psalm:

Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own.

(Ps 33)

Second Reading:

For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, "Abba, Father!"

(Rom 8:15)

Gospel:

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

(Mt 28:19)



"We celebrate the central mystery of our Christian faith: one God in three divine persons."

For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the spirit of sonship. When we cry, "Abba! Father!" it is the Spirit himself bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children then heirs, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

- Romans 8:14-17

Today's solemn feast of the Most Holy Trinity recognizes and celebrates the central mystery of our Christian faith: one God in three divine persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Within God there is an eternal and dynamic relationship of love – love freely poured out by the Father to the Son, and returned by the Son to the Father, in the power of the Holy Spirit.

If, as we profess, God is love, then there must be a Lover, the Beloved, and the Love between them. This love pours out into God's creation, and through the Father's adoption of his sons and daughters in Baptism, he claims us as his own and welcomes us into this dynamic of love.

This unfathomable mystery of God's very being, and our insertion into his inner life, is at the center of what we believe. What love he has for us!
