PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Today's Readings

Last week was a tragic and historic time in our nation. The shocking attempted assassination of President Trump in Pennsylvania occupied our attention and troubled our hearts.

The death of an attendee at the campaign event was particularly awful. We seem to be living in brutal times, characterized by vitriol, cruelty, division, anger and bitterness.

The constant coverage (through 24-hour news, social media, podcasts, YouTube videos, etc.) keeps these disturbing occurrences before us at all times. With such turmoil everywhere our inner peace can be disrupted.

In the Gospel passage today, we read that Jesus' heart was moved with pity as He looked at the crowds of people who were, "like sheep without a shepherd."

We might ask ourselves who our shepherd is. Is it Jesus? Or do we follow the various media stars, political figures, celebrities, and so on?

Our Blessed Mother Mary encouraged people to look always to Jesus. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. The misguided and often deadly values of this world are not the answer to our conflicts. Jesus is!

Let's look to Him, the Good Shepherd, especially in these perilous times. And let's pray for our nation, that it may return to the Christian values on which it was founded.

Climate Change: A Matter Of Faith? Yes.

While some have wrongly turned climate change into a political issue, Pope Francis (following John Paul II and Benedict) recognizes it as a social justice and a moral issue. Those who will suffer most from the resulting environmental damage are the poor and future generations.

Francis calls upon individuals, governments and corporations to make changes to mitigate the problem. He has met with top energy company executives, and they have agreed to support policies that put a price on carbon emissions. The US Conference of Catholic Bishops also has issued a statement of past support for legislation that puts a price on carbon emissions to encourage a switch to clean energy, without economically harming the poor or middle class.

The severe human costs, that will be a consequence of doing nothing, make this a moral issue and a matter of concern and action as part of our faith.
