

Dear Friends,

"If it does not please you to serve the LORD, decide today whom you will serve, the gods your fathers served beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose country you are now dwelling. As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."

There is nothing new under the sun. Choosing the God we serve is a question for every generation. In our own time, the question seems more timely and more stark than at any time in our lives. The political campaigns for the presidency have been particularly troubling, as *ad hominem* attacks fly between the parties and the candidates, and we find that there doesn't seem to be a place for us in any party.

Whom do I serve? To whom do I belong? I believe that as Catholics we know that no political party can be our true home. The two major parties have their own challenges for those who belong to Jesus. As informed Catholics, we have to make a prudent choice when we vote. In the next weeks, I will share the guidance of the U.S. Bishops Conference on voting according to our Catholic faith.

The war and violence in the Middle East, and the glorification of war by so many world leaders is a terrible attack on the dignity of men and women.

I will honestly say that Planned
Parenthood's offer of appointments for
free medical abortions and vasectomies
in Chicago this past week was especially
sickening and deplorable. I was in tears
when I heard about this. Killing our
children and sterilizing our men is surely a
demonic plan. But giving access to these
procedures is presented in our culture as a
virtuous act. We must pray for our nation,
that God will forgive these atrocities and
turn us back to Him!






