"If we let Christ into our lives, we lose nothing, nothing, absolutely nothing of what makes life free, beautiful and great. The person who abandons himself totally in God's hands does not become God's puppet, a boring 'yes man'; he does not lose his freedom".


"The world offers you comfort, but you were not made for comfort. You were




