Today's solemnity of Christ the King is the culmination and completion of the liturgical year. It marks both the present reality and the future consummation of the world, when Jesus, the Son of the Father, crucified and risen to glory, will visible and triumphantly return as King of the Universe.

He has conquered death through his humility and his obedience to the Father, and he offers the new and glorious eternal life he won for us to all who accept his invitation to, "come, follow me." The pursuit of holiness necessarily means a surrender of many of our own desires, possessions and plans. It requires giving ourselves completely to him.

Pope Benedict XVIII said this in his inaugural homily as Pope:

"If we let Christ into our lives, we lose nothing, nothing, absolutely nothing of what makes life free, beautiful and great. The person who abandons himself totally in God's hands does not become God's puppet, a boring 'yes man'; he does not lose his freedom".

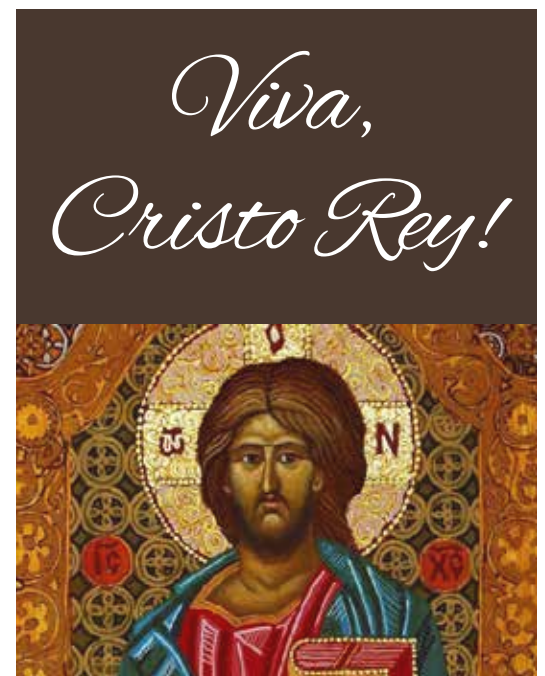
"The world offers you comfort, but you were not made for comfort. You were
