Anna and Simeon are beautiful examples of faith and trust in God. They are models of faith for people of all generations. Their faithfulness was rewarded by the God who keeps his promises.



Volunteers Needed



"St. James has been a beacon of hope:

- You collected and delivered Welcome Packs to five newly arrived refugee families in the Chicago area.
- In April, you hosted the Refugee Journey Simulation which engendered empathy and inspired action on behalf of local refugees. Also in April, your efforts for the EWS's Celebration of Hope gala galvanized a powerful force for refugees' good.
- In February you invited EWS to connect with the Seton Assembly of the Knights of Columbus. And throughout the year you empowered volunteers to serve in EWS's New Neighbor program working with families in Chicago."
- Your financial support of EWS's education programming, and ongoing participation in the Prayer Partnership Team have been consistent sources of strength and encouragement."

Refugees entering the U.S. are the most thoroughly vetted individuals allowed in our country. Refugees pay for their own travel to the U.S. through a Revolving Loan Fund. Refugees are invited to resettle by the U.S. government and enter as legal residents. Refugees pay taxes and are contributors to the U.S. economy.




