# Today's Readings

#### **Gospel:**

Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and followed him. (Lk 5:10-11)

Dear Friends,

Over the past couple of weeks, Fr. Paul, Fr. Michael and I have been spending time with our school's fourth graders teaching about the meaning of the Mass. They watched a short, but powerfully moving video called The Veil Removed which shows the joining of heaven and earth in the Liturgy of the Eucharist. This extraordinary illustration of the coming together of the entire Communion of Saints and the ranks of angels at every Mass made a powerful impression on our young people, our teachers and on me. I strongly recommend watching this short, 7-minute video which can be found on YouTube.

Isaiah writes about the mystical vision he received of the heavenly worship of God and of his awareness of his complete unworthiness to be there - "Woe is me, I am doomed! For I am a man of unclean lips, living among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!" However, he was made worthy by God through a seraph touching a burning ember from the altar to Isaiah's lips, purging him of his sin and removing his wickedness.

Peter and Paul have a similar reaction upon encountering the Lord. Peter says to Jesus after the miraculous catch, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Likewise, Paul writes to the

Corinthians, "For I am the least of the apostles, not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God."

These three great apostles and prophets of our faith were overcome with awe in the presence of the Lord, and aware of their sinfulness. But all were sent out by God to proclaim his word.

We begin each Mass acknowledging our unworthiness in the Confiteor. With this prayer we look at ourselves honestly and ask for mercy. The Lord then sends us out into the world to do his work, strengthened by his grace and mercy, fed with his Body and Blood.






## Singers at State
