Today's Readings

First Reading:

Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose hope is the Lord. (Jer 17:7)

Psalm:

Blessed are they who hope in the Lord. (Ps 1)

Second Reading:

If the dead are not raised, neither has Christ been raised, and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is vain. (1 Cor 15:16-17)

Gospel:

"Blessed are you who are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours." (Lk 6:20) Dear Friends,

St. Luke's account of the sermon on the Beatitudes is slightly different from St. Matthew's, but substantially the same important message. Jesus' teaching on the meaning of blessing and blessedness is perhaps not exactly what we would expect, or think we desire.

Strong's Lexicon says this: "In ancient Greek culture, "makarios" was often associated with the gods or the dead, who were considered to be in a state of bliss. However, in the biblical context, it is used to describe the blessedness of those who live in accordance with God's will. The term reflects a counter-cultural understanding of happiness, one that is not dependent on external circumstances but on one's spiritual condition and relationship with God."

It's not just a future promise, but it also denotes a present reality - the reality that for those who are justified, or living in right relationship, all will be well, even in times of tremendous trial.

The prayer of St. Teresa of Avila is fitting: "Let nothing disturb you, Let nothing frighten you, All things are passing away: God never changes. Patience obtains all things Whoever has God lacks nothing; God alone suffices."
