and make not your heritage a reproach, with the nations ruling over them! Why should they say among the peoples, 'Where is their God?' Then the LORD was stirred to concern for his land and took pity on his people. Joel 2:17-18

Dear Friends,

Greetings on this first Sunday of Lent. Lent is an important season of preparation and penance in anticipation of Easter. As we heard in the first reading on Ash Wednesday, the prophet Joel exhorts the people of Israel to repent from their sin and beg the Lord's mercy. As the Book of Hebrews instructs us, we have a great High Priest, Jesus Christ, who now pleads for us, His people, before the Father. He who offered His very life in sacrifice on our behalf, makes that sacrifice present to us at every Mass, and invites us to join ourselves to Him in this offering. Daily Mass is a powerful way to observe Lent.

Fasting and almsgiving, along with prayer, are the classic ways to observe Lent. Fasting is the willful forgoing of a good, in order to clear the way in our hearts and souls to receive the grace the Lord intends for us. Almsgiving is our gift to the poor, incarnating the love of God for our neighbor. Liturgical prayer (the Mass), devotional prayer such as the Stations of the Cross, or the Rosary, and contemplative prayer such as Eucharistic adoration are some ways of deepening our intimacy with God. Please receive the sacrament of Confession (Reconciliation) before Easter.

Our catechumens and candidates for full communion with the Catholic Church have been preparing since September by attending weekly sessions exploring the faith in depth. Next month we will be going to the cathedral for the Rite of Election with the cardinal. See the photo and names on page 3, and please keep them in your prayers.

### **Lenten Regulations**

**FASTING:** Catholics ages 18–59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means eating one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal. Snacking between meals is not allowed

**ABSTINENCE:** Catholics ages 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

### New Bishop Appointed for St. James and Vicariate I

Recently, five new Auxiliary Bishops were ordained by Cardinal Cupich for the Archdiocese of Chicago. Bishop Timothy J. O'Malley has been assigned to Vicariate I, which is the Vicariate to which St. James belongs.

Bishop O'Malley was born in Evergreen Park, Illinois, in 1959. He holds a B.S. in Management from Purdue University, a CPA, and a J.D. from DePaul University College of Law.

After discerning a call to the priesthood, he earned an STB and Master of Divinity from the University of Saint Mary of the Lake and was ordained in 1997. He served as associate pastor at St. Agnes of Bohemia Parish and as pastor of St. James Parish, Highwood; St. Joseph Parish, Round Lake; and St. Genevieve Parish, Chicago.

He currently serves as pastor of Most Blessed Trinity Parish in Waukegan. In addition, he has been a member of the Priests' Placement Board and Dean in Vicariates IVC, IVA and IB."


