# Today's Readings

#### First Reading:

God exalted him at his right hand as leader and savior to grant Israel repentance and forgiveness of sins. (Acts 5:31)

#### Psalm:

I will praise you, Lord, for you have rescued me. (Ps 30)

#### Second Reading:

"To the one who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor, glory and might, forever and ever." (Rv 5:13)

#### Gospel:

Jesus said to them, "Children, have you caught anything to eat?" They answered him, "No." So he said to them, "Cast the net over the right side of the boat and you will find something." So they cast it, and were not able to pull it in because of the number of fish. (Jn 21:5-6)

Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" - John 21:15

Dear Friends,

Today we are treated to this powerful and emotional passage from John Chapter 20, in which Simon Peter meets Jesus after his resurrection, and has this healing and reaffirming encounter with him. Peter, who denied Jesus three times as Jesus was going to his death, is given this opportunity to reaffirm his faith and love for the Lord. "Do you love me?"

I think one of the most poignant moments in this passage is Peter jumping into the sea when he learns that Jesus is on the shore. He rushes to Jesus and is reconciled with him. His vocation is reaffirmed.

The call of Jesus is irrevocable. Peter is sent forth to "feed my sheep." Peter is also reminded that there will be a cost to following this call. "When you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go."

St. Peter is a realistic model of discipleship. He hasn't perfected it, but he will at the end of his life when he willingly accepts crucifixion and death out of his love for Jesus and for

his people. God's grace enabled him to do this.

Another of the Apostles, our patron saint, James the Lesser, also gave his life for love of Jesus and his people. Today we celebrate his feast day. (His feast, shared with St. Philip the Apostle, is actually May 3, but we can transfer it to the nearest Sunday because he is our parish patron).

St. James is known as the son of Alphaeus in the Gospels. It is believed that he is called "the Lesser' because was either younger or shorter than James the Greater, not because he was less important!

James was instrumental in the Council of Jerusalem in 50 A.D., which ruled that the Church was open to all and that all people could be saved by living as followers of Jesus.
