Dear Friends,

The past month has been a time of great emotion as we marked the death of Pope Francis on Easter Monday, and went through the official nine days of mourning - the Novemdiales, during which daily Masses were offered for the repose of his soul,

even as preparations were made for the conclave which would elect the nex successor of St. Peter.

On Saturday April 26, a funeral mass was offered for the Holy Father, and he was entombed within the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore. Four days later, the conclave began as the

133 cardinal electors entered the Sistine Chapel, and the next day the news was announced to the word, "Habemus Papam" – we have a pope. To the great surprise of many, Robert Cardinal Prevost, a Chicago area native, was elected as pope, and took the name Leo XIV.

There was an abundance of pride and joy in Chicago as one of our own greeted the world as the Vicar of Christ from the loggia of St. Peter's Basilica. Let us keep Pope Leo XIV in our prayers as he begins his papacy. May God provide him with every grace he needs as he leads Christ's

Church.

During those heady days in Rome since Easter, life went on as usual at St. James. We joyfully celebrated Confirmation and First Communion here and 300 young people received one of the two sacraments. Congratulations to all and thanks to those who worked so faithfully to prepare them.

The St. James Parish Youth Choirs are open to students from any school.


