## First Reading:

The Holy Spirit comes to the apostles, enabling them to speak in many languages, signaling that God's message is for all nations. (Acts 2:1-11)

Dear Friends,

The powerful story of the coming of the Holy Spirit, the promised Advocate, tells of what is sometimes called the "birthday of the Church." The saving work of Jesus has been completed, and He has returned to the Father. But He did not leave the Church as orphans. His Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Trinity, God Himself, has come down in a powerful way.

Earlier, on the first Easter, John's Gospel tells us that Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

- John 20:20,23

Jesus has equipped His Church to make His saving acts on the Cross and in the Resurrection present to the Church in every time and place. That includes our time and place. We have a mission – to preach the Gospel and make disciples of all. By this is salvation made real and effective in our lives. And Jesus has equipped us with all that we need for this mission: the Scriptures, the sacraments, the Apostolic faith, and over all of this, the presence and action of the Holy Spirit.





ave vou ever wondered why we call ourselves Catholic Christians? We read in the book of the Acts of Apostles in the Bible: "Then he (Barnabas) went to Tarsus to look for Saul, and when he had found him he brought him to Antioch. For a whole year they met with the church and taught a large number of people, and it was in Antioch that the disciples were first called Christians." A Christian is one who believes in Jesus, the God-man, who saves the world by his passion, death, and resurrection. A Christian believes that Jesus is the Son, who teaches us about the Father and the Holy Spirit; one God in three persons.

It is again from Antioch that we received the second part of our name. St. Ignatius of Antioch, writing in 107AD, spoke of the Church as "Catholic," specifically with the Greek word katholicos, meaning "universal." The Church is for everyone, Jews and Greeks/gentiles. It doesn't matter from which country or people you come; God calls everyone to belong to himself in Christ Jesus. As far as the word "Church" is concerned, it is Greek, ekklesia, meaning "(those) called out of." The Church is comprised of Jews and gentiles: those called out of sin and death into life, those called out of darkness into light.

That is why in today's second reading, St. Paul reminds us that, "[I]n one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit." The new covenant that Jesus established opened the doors of salvation to the whole world. Pentecost is when the mission truly began. The Holy Spirit descended upon the

apostles, empowering them to speak in many languages and boldly proclaim the Gospel. People from all nations understood them, a clear sign that the Church was for everyone. Today, the Catholic Church continues this mission. With over a billion members worldwide, we are still one body in Christ.

## **Reflection Questions:**

- What does it mean to you personally that the Catholic Church is "universal" and open to all people, regardless of background or nationality?
- In what ways can you, like the apostles at Pentecost, be bold in sharing your faith with others today?
- How does understanding the origins and mission of the Catholic Church help you grow in your relationship with Christ and the larger Christian community?

## **Statement of Cardinal Cupich** on SB 1950 Assisted Suicide Bill

May 30, 2025

Last night, SB 1950 was passed in the Illinois House of Representatives. This bill which will go to the Illinois State Senate for consideration today enshrines in law the right to end one's life with physician involvement and approval.\*

I have to ask why, in a time when growing understanding of the deteriorating mental health of the U.S. population – and particularly among our youth - caused the country to create the 988 mental health crisis line, we would want to take this step to normalize suicide as a solution to life's challenges. While the bill sets parameters for assisted suicide, the data from places where assisted suicide is available are clear. Rates of all suicide went up after the passage of such legislation. These rates are already unacceptably high, and proposed cutbacks in medical care funding will add to the burden faced by those contemplating suicide.

Let us also consider the impact on impressionable young people of legalizing suicide in any form. According to a 2022 United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention study, suicide is the second-leading cause of death for U.S. teens and young adults 10-34. It is the second-leading cause of death for those 10-14. And, according to the National Institutes of Health, suicide contagion is a real risk to these young people after exposure to suicide. Add to that the ready availability of firearms in the U.S. and this is a tragedy we do not need to compound.

I speak to this topic not only as a religious leader but also as one who has seen a parent die from a debilitating illness. My father was kept comfortable and was cherished until his natural death. Catholic teaching supports such palliative care so long as the goal is not to end life. There is a way to both honor the dignity of human life and provide compassionate care to those experiencing lifeending illness. Surely the Illinois legislature should explore those options before making suicide one of the avenues available to the ill and distressed.

\* Update: The Illinois Senate adjourned May 31 without calling for a vote on SB 1950.


