When I was a child, I was very affected by the idea of the Eucharist. I didn't learn anything about the sacrament in my Catholic grade school in those days after the Second Vatican Council.

In my Catholic high school, however, I was blessed with a holy priest, Father Philip Cahill, who taught us real Catholic theology, particularly about the meaning and mystery of the Mass.

I will always remember Father Cahill teaching us about the "unbloody sacrifice of the altar." I was so intrigued by that powerful image and began reading more deeply about the real meaning of the Mass.

Exploring this idea opened a whole new world to me. I learned that the Mass is a *re-presentation* of Calvary. Jesus' self-sacrifice on the Cross is present and real on the altar at every Mass. We are to join our

own lives - our joys, struggles, and hopes - to Jesus in His sacrifice.

Today is the feast of Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ. It is a feast dedicated to the presence of the sacrament of Jesus Himself really and truly present with us in the Eucharist.

On this beautiful feast of Corpus Christi, we offer ourselves to the Lord, and join ourselves to Him in His loving offering to the Father.

f you go to an evangelical or mainline Protestant church, you probably will not see what you see in Catholic Church: communion every day. Some of those churches only have communion on Sundays, some only once in a great while. And if you ask them, what is communion, they will generally tell you it is bread and wine that reminds us of Jesus and what he has done for us.

So what is with us Catholics? In English, when we hear Jesus say, "Do this in remembrance of me," we often think of a simple mental recollection. But the New Testament is written in Koine Greek. The usual word for "remember" is mimneskomai, which is similar to our English word, evoking the concept of a mental connection. However, the word Jesus actually used was anamnesis. This Greek word is more unusual, and means that, by recalling (God's) action of the past, it becomes present here and now. Thus, by repeating Jesus' words and actions, the bread and wine become Jesus himself here and now.

At the Last Supper - celebrated during Passover - Jesus connected His sacrifice on the cross to the ancient deliverance of Israel from slavery in Egypt. Just as the Israelites had to eat the Passover lamb to partake in God's salvation, so too we must partake of the true Lamb of God, Jesus Christ, who takes away the sins of the world. We describe our participation in the sacrifice of Christ for our salvation through the word *transubstantiation*. The substance of bread and wine truly becomes

the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ, though the appearance of bread and wine remains the same.

So why wouldn't we have Communion every day? If Christ Himself becomes present to offer salvation, to nourish us for eternal life, and to unite us to His sacrifice - how could we not?

Reflection Questions:

- What does it mean to you personally that, through *anamnesis*, Christ's sacrifice becomes present at every Mass, rather than just being a memory?
- How does understanding the Eucharist as truly Christ's Body and Blood (through transubstantiation) change the way you approach receiving Communion?
- If the Eucharist is the ongoing gift of Christ's saving presence, how might you deepen your devotion to the Mass and make it a greater priority in your life?



Devotions, **Explained**

Marian consecration, the act of consecrating oneself to Jesus through the intercession of his Blessed Mother, is actually rooted in the words of Jesus himself when he beseeched the Apostle John to look upon Mary as his mother (John 19:27) and to "take her into his own home." He was actually instructing us all to do likewise - to "behold your mother" and take Mary into our hearts, for wherever she is beloved, Christ is known and praised.

St. Maximilian Kolbe described Mary as "the stairway to Heaven." Marian consecration, therefore, could be likened to climbing the stairs. Different formulas exist for spiritual development in preparation for the consecration, based on the writings of saints like St. Louis de Montfort, and there are different prayers for the act of consecration. However, there is no "right" way to consecrate oneself to Jesus through Mary, so long as the ultimate goal is closeness to Christ and the glorification of God.




