Today's Readings

First Reading: This reading invites

us to seek meaning beyond earthly labor; without purpose in God, work can feel meaningless. (Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23)

Psalm:

God is eternal; human life is brief. Seek His mercy, wisdom, and lasting significance. (Psalm 90)

Second Reading:

St. Paul invites us to set our hearts on Christ above: put off the old self and live renewed in God's image. (Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11)

Gospel:

Jesus warns against greed through a parable, teaching that true life and security come from spiritual, not material, wealth. (Luke 12:13-21)

Dear Friends,

In *The Religion of the Day*, authors Dr. Jonathan Reyes and Msgr. James Shea describe a new secular form of contemporary religion which has come on the scene. What struck me in particular in this secular worldview is the lack of a supernatural faith. All seems immanent and material. God seems largely absent, except in an abstract way.

In today's Gospel, Jesus does not denounce wealth itself, but he offers a serious caution: "Be on guard against all forms of greed; for though someone may be rich, life does not consist in an abundance of possessions." In my experience in parish life, I find it continually necessary and at times urgent to remind both myself and the community that the ultimate aim of the Christian life is communion with God through Jesus Christ.

Even now, we are given a foretaste of that eternal communion as a free and gracious gift. As the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us, "For here we have no lasting city, but we are looking for the city that is to come" (Hebrews 13:14). Every act of love,

every work for justice, and every service rendered to others must flow from our living relationship with Christ.

As you know, we have achieved our goal for the Vibrant Generations capital campaign. Through the magnanimous generosity of so many, \$4 million was pledged to support the particular needs of St. James as well as some of the needs of the archdiocese. One of the great graces that I received from the campaign was the realization that so many are very happy with the life of our parish and willing to sacrifice for the good of the parish. Thank you!





oday's readings remind us to strive to be rich in what truly matters: the things that matter to God. Money, possessions and status can easily consume our lives, but they do not satisfy the deepest hunger of the human heart. As St. Teresa of Calcutta once said, many suffer from a deep spiritual poverty: "You... have millions of people who suffer such terrible loneliness and emptiness... What they are missing, really, is a living relationship with God."

Jesus addresses this reality in today's Gospel from Luke. A man asks Him to settle an inheritance dispute, and Jesus refuses, warning instead about greed. He tells a parable of a rich man who stores up earthly wealth but neglects his soul. When the man dies, all his riches are meaningless. Jesus concludes, "Thus will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God."

So what are real riches? We might include love of God, love of neighbor, and holiness. These riches grow from a life rooted in prayer, the sacraments, and service. As St. Paul reminds us in today's second reading, if we're not living in and for Jesus, we will never be truly rich.

Although God calls each of us to holiness, not everyone's call is the same. People like Pier Giorgio Frassati showed us how to live richly in Christ. He was not a priest or missionary, but a student who lived a simple life of service and prayer. Like St. Thérèse of Lisieux observed, holiness is found in little things done with great love.

To grow in real riches, you might ask yourself: do I love my spouse, my children, my neighbor as Christ does? Do I seek God daily in prayer and the sacraments?

Because in the end, the only riches that matter are the ones that lead us to heaven.

Reflection Questions:

- What areas of my life show that I am seeking earthly riches over the riches that matter to God?
- How am I actively growing in love for God and my neighbor?
- Do I believe that holiness and a deep relationship with Jesus are the real purpose and fulfillment of my life?




