At St. James, we call this process "Come and See," also known as the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). It's an invitation for those who are curious about the Catholic Faith. It includes those who may feel a prompting in their heart to explore what it means to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

Whether someone is unbaptized, baptized in another Christian tradition, or simply searching for deeper meaning, OCIA provides a space to ask questions, grow in understanding, and prepare for full communion through Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.

Our first gathering will be **Tuesday**, **September 9 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Laramie Room (lower level of the church). If you know anyone who may be interested, please invite them.

Jesus reminds us in today's Gospel to, "Gird your loins and light your lamps... You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." These words are a call to readiness, not

just for ourselves, but to help others be ready as well. The OCIA process is one such way we keep our lamps lit and help others prepare their hearts and minds to receive Christ.

Our faith is a gift we are called to share. If you or someone you know has questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to me, Fr. Paul, or Fr. Michael. We would be honored to speak with them and invite them to begin this faith journey.




Volunteer Opportunities:

Members of our ministry will be available next weekend after the 5:00 PM Mass on Saturday and Sunday to answer questions.


