# Today's Readings

#### First Reading:

God condemns the greedy who exploit the poor; He will not forget their injustice.

Amos 8:4-7

God is exalted above all yet cares for the lowly, raising and blessing them.

Pray for all people, including leaders; God desires salvation for all through Christ, calling believers to live holy, peaceful lives.

1 Timothy 2:1-8

#### Gospel:

Jesus teaches through the dishonest steward that true disciples must wisely steward resources, serving God faithfully, for no one can serve both God and wealth.

Luke 16:1-13

Dear Friends,

Religious indifferentism is the belief that all religions are equally valid paths to God or truth, or that it doesn't matter which faith one follows. It's a popular belief today, but one condemned by the Church as a heresy. St. Paul wrote to Timothy:

"God our savior...wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. For there is one God. There is also one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as ransom for all, (1 Timothy 2:3-5)."

God's desire is that each one of us be saved and come to knowledge of the truth. And the Truth is Jesus Christ. Jesus himself told his disciples, "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me." The mission of the Church is to preach this truth to the world. There is an urgency to this mission.

What, then, must we do?

- "Pray, lifting up holy hands, without anger or argument, (1 Timothy 2:8)."
- "Be trustworthy in very small matters and also in great ones, (Luke: 16:10)."
- Care for the poor. (Amos 8)

These things we do, and the way we act toward God and others are not earning us salvation, but rather, ought to flow from our encounter with God and his grace – the very inner life of the Trinity. We receive that sanctifying grace through the worthy reception of the sacraments and actual grace through our virtuous acts.

Exodus World Service will speak before the Masses on the October 4-5 weekend, which is the Catholic Church's 111th World Day of Migrants and Refugees.


