Dear Friends,

The month of October is Pro-Life Month, a time when the Church emphasizes deliberately her teaching on the holiness of human life, particularly in the womb, as well as in vulnerable situations. Our bishops, through the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, have identified abortion as the, "fundamental human rights issue and a preeminent concern for Catholic voters, alongside euthanasia."

Here are fundamental teachings about life issues which are unchanging Catholic moral beliefs:

- Human life is sacred and possesses inherent dignity from conception to natural death.
- Direct abortion is a gravely immoral act because it is the intentional killing of an innocent human being.
- The Church's teaching on the immorality of abortion has been constant since the earliest days of the Church and remains unchangeable.
- Abortion is a fundamental attack on the inviolable right to life, the most basic human right.

The Church acknowledges that abortion can cause deep wounds to the women and men involved and offers support for post-abortion healing. Groups such as Rachel's Vineyard (www.rachelsvineyard.org) are particularly effective in offering post-abortive healing. The sacrament of Confession is a powerful opportunity for grace, forgiveness, and

healing for those who have been involved in the trauma of abortion. Aid for Women (www.aidforwomen.org) offers support and assistance to women who face challenging pregnancies

The USCCB challenges the idea of abortion as "healthcare" and advocates for a "civilization of love" where people are cherished over things.

Let's pray for an end to the cruel act of abortion, and for a change of heart in our nation, so that abortion will become unthinkable, all human life will be protected, and that women in crisis are offered love and support. I thank our Respect Life group at St. James for their faithful and unwavering advocacy and love for the most vulnerable people among us.




WE REMEMBER

The names of those who have died and were buried from St. James in the past year will be spoken at the 5:00 pm Mass on Saturday, November 1.


As the departed are always remembered with love in our hearts, however, participation is not strictly limited to those who have lost someone in the past year. All are welcome.




Calling All Knitters and Crocheters
