Welcome to Father Joe Uhen, also known as Padre Jose, who is here this weekend to share his work with us and to ask for our support. Padre Jose is the pastor of Santísimo Sacramento Parish in Piura, Peru. Piura is located in the north, in the Archdiocese of Piura. It's not far from the Diocese of Chiclayo, where Pope Leo XIV served as bishop for many years before being called to Rome to serve as the prefect of the Congregation of Bishops.

Santísimo Sacramento (Most Blessed Sacrament) Parish is a vibrant Catholic



community carrying out extensive outreach to the surrounding villages, including a large school serving elementary and high school students, a hospice and physical and occupational therapy facilities. The parish also builds homes in local communities, shelters victims of domestic violence, feeds the hungry, and provides a credit union for local farmers, just to name a few of their apostolates. At the heart of the work of the parish is Jesus in the Eucharist and the proclamation of the Gospel.

I have visited the village a number of times to serve with Padre Jose. During my tenure at the seminary, I accompanied a group of seminarians each year on a mission trip to Piura where we served together. It is always a great joy to be there with the staff of Santísimo Sacramento and the local people.








Calling All Knitters and Crocheters





KNOWLEDGE IS POWER

Breast Cancer Awareness Month

A Message of Hope and Healing

Breast cancer affects one in eight women during their lifetime, and while it is more common in women, men can be affected too. Early detection through mammograms, self-exams, and regular check-ups can save lives. When found early, breast cancer is highly treatable.

As the Catholic Bishops stated in Part One #3, of the Ethical and Religious Directives for Health Care Services, "in accord with its mission. Catholic health care should distinguish itself by service to and advocacy for those people whose social condition puts them at the margins of our society and makes them particularly vulnerable to discrimination: the poor; the uninsured and the underinsured; children and the unborn; single parents; the elderly; those with incurable diseases and chemical dependencies; racial minorities; immigrants and refugees."

This call to service and advocacy is especially important when we consider breast cancer. Research shows that Black women are 40 percent more likely to die from breast cancer than White women. Latina and Samoan women are also more likely to die from the disease despite having a lower incidence of the disease compared to white women.

Ways We Can Help

- · Pray for those currently battling breast cancer, survivors, caregivers, and families.
- · Encourage loved ones to schedule screenings and practice healthy lifestyles.

Breast Cancer Screening Guidelines:

- · Ages 40 to 44: Women may choose to begin annual mammograms if they wish
- · Ages 45 to 54: Annual mammograms are recommended
- · Ages 55 and older: Mammograms every 2 years, or continue yearly if
- · Continue screening if a woman is in good health and expected to live 10+ more years




