

Dear Friends,

St. Paul writes to Timothy as he prepares for his impending death, encouraging his co-worker in the vineyard of the Lord. Paul is under arrest in Rome, where he will be put to death under the emperor Nero in the early 60s. Paul seems to be reviewing his life, including his successes and challenges, and sense of being abandoned by many of his brothers in the faith. His faith in God and his hope for salvation are unwavering, however: "From now on there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the just judge, will award to me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing." 2 Tim 4:8

Next Saturday at 5 pm we will have our annual All Souls Day Mass with music from our Sacred Sounds choral ensemble. All Souls Day is particularly focused on the faithful departed. We pray particularly for the dead, that they may be purified on their journey to final union with God in Heaven. We will remember especially those who have died in the past year. May they, who have fought the good fight, finished the race and kept the faith, received the

crown of righteousness, to which Paul looked forward as he came to the end of his life.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and may the perpetual light shine upon them. Amen.

Bereavement Ministry




Our group provides training. New ministers "shadow" a current minister until they become comfortable soloing. When a funeral reaches the Parish Office, an email is sent to all bereavement ministers. The first one who is available sends a response to the office and copies our group. The process of contacting the family begins then.
