Dear Friends,

There is an urgency in the Scripture readings for this first Sunday of Advent. The emphasis is on the End Times and the Second Coming of Jesus. Eric J. Wagner, CR, writes the following concerning the readings we will hear proclaimed during Advent:

"As we begin Advent, we strive to renew the fervor of our hope as we await the Lord's coming. Thus, our waiting takes on a twofold character. On one hand, we prepare to joyously celebrate at Christmas the Lord's first coming among us. On the other hand, we also wait in hope for the Lord's return at the end of time - his second coming. Advent helps us renew our interior attentiveness to the Lord and opens us to God's grace."

During this time of anticipation, we have opportunities to prepare spiritually for a more intense and deeper interaction with Jesus:

- Daily Mass will be offered at noon Monday through Friday through Dec. 23 (in addition to our regular schedule).
- Sacred Sounds Concert Series: Advent Lessons and Carols Sat., Dec. 6 at noon.

- The Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Holy Day of Obligation, is Mon., Dec. 8. Masses will be offered at 7:30 a.m., Noon, and 7:00 p.m.
- Along with our regular confession times, there are three Multi-Parish Confession opportunities: Mon. Dec. 15 at 7:00 p.m. at St. Colette in Rolling Meadows, Tues. Dec. 16 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Cecelia in Mt. Prospect, and Wed. Dec. 17 at 7:00 p.m. here at St. James.

I invite you to a deeper and closer walk with the Lord as we prepare for the coming holy days. St. Paul wrote to the Church in Rome, "It is the hour now for you to awake from sleep. For our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed; the night is advanced, the day is at hand. Let us then throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light."(Romans 13:12)






