Dear Friends,

People have asked what the Church's teaching on immigration is. That's a very timely question, considering what is going on these days in our nation. The answer is that the Church does not have a definitive teaching on the particulars of immigration policy. What the Church does have is general teachings which ought to be applied to the current situation. Let me present them.

- Political authorities, for the sake of the common good for which they are responsible, may make the exercise of the right to immigrate subject to various juridical conditions, especially with regard to the immigrants' duties toward their country of adoption. Immigrants are obliged to respect with gratitude the material and spiritual heritage of the country that receives them, to obey its laws, and to assist in carrying civic burdens (CCC 2241).
- As the Catechism notes (again in para. 2241): "The more prosperous nations are obliged, to the extent they are able, to welcome the foreigner in search of the security and the means of livelihood which he cannot find in his country of origin."

 Christian charity requires each of us to treat all of those with whom we come into contact with the dignity that they deserve. This speaks, then, not so much to the question of immigration policy (that is, who is allowed to enter the country and under what conditions) but of how immigrants are to be treated once they have arrived.

Immigration policy is one of those areas in which we, as informed and well-formed Catholics, are to make prudential decisions, based on these principles, about the way forward. Neither the Pope nor the bishops have the definitive answer. This is the responsibility of the laity, having been formed by the teachings of the Church.

As we go forward in our national search for a just and respectful policy on immigration, maybe we can refer to these three principles as we seek solutions to our current challenges.

Celebrating Women Mass






