



Today's Readings

First Reading

God's chosen servant brings justice gently, a light to nations, freeing captives and restoring hope through faithful obedience.

Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7

Second Reading

God shows no favoritism; Jesus, anointed by the Spirit, brought peace and healing, doing good and freeing the oppressed.

Acts 10:34-38

Gospel

Jesus is baptized by John; the Spirit descends, and God declares Jesus His beloved Son, affirming His mission.

Matthew 3:13-17

After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

Dear Friends,

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. The baptism of Jesus was obviously not Christian Baptism, but a baptism of repentance. Jesus, the Son of God did not need to be baptized, but his baptism was a sign of his taking on the human condition entirely, becoming one of us, and taking all our sins and failings on himself.


Our Christian Baptism is a corollary to this. By our baptism, we take on a new identity, that of son or daughter of God. The old self dies in the waters of baptism, and the new man arises from the water as beloved son or daughter. The Christian's identity is changed forever by the power of this sacrament. Sanctifying grace (the very love of the Trinity) is poured forth, original sin and any actual sin (in the case of adults) are forgiven (and any punishment for sin is wiped away). An indelible mark is imposed on the soul, which identifies the Christian as a son or daughter of God.

In fact, St. Augustine wrote that when God the Father sees the soul of one who is baptized, He recognizes him, because he looks like Jesus.

Through Baptism, we receive salvation and we are admitted to the other sacraments, those grace-filled, intimate encounters with the living God. This is why we believe that newborn babies should be brought to Baptism as soon as possible after birth. As the Catechism states, "Holy baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit." Our God desires that all his creatures receive the salvation won by His Son Jesus. The way to this is Baptism.
