Today's Readings

First Reading

True worship is caring for the needy; compassion brings God's light, healing, and guidance into life.

Isaiah 58:7-10

Second Reading

Paul preached Christ with humility and weakness, relying on God's Spirit and power so faith would rest on God, not human wisdom.

Gospel

Jesus calls His followers salt and light, urging them to live visibly good lives so others may glorify God through their deeds.

Matthew 5:13-16

Dear Friends,

"He's the salt of the earth" is an expression I've sometimes heard as words of praise for a person. It connotes reliability, trustworthiness, stability, trust.

In the Bible, there are a number of references to "covenants of salt" in the Old Testament. First, the Covenant of Salt cited by King Abija in 2 Chronicles 13:5 refers to the unbreakable, perpetual covenant with David's lineage to rule the nation of Israel.

Secondly, in Numbers 18:19, God makes a covenant of salt with Aaron regarding the priesthood which has been given perpetually to the Tribe of Levi. Thirdly, Leviticus 2:14 recounts God's instruction to the Levites, "you shall not let the covenant of salt with your God be lacking from your cereal offering."

Jesus calls his disciples *salt of the earth*. His is in covenant with us – a permanent and irrevocable covenant, an exchange of persons, not simply a legal agreement. This covenant is sealed on the cross in the blood of Jesus. When St. Paul writes to the Corinthians, "I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ, and him crucified...so that your faith might rest not on human wisdom but on the power of God," he is speaking of this covenant. What appears to be weakness – the crucifixion and death of Jesus – is really the power of God. (1 Cor 2:2,5).

In the consecration of the wine at Mass, Jesus' words are repeated by the priest, "Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins."

By this covenant and action of Jesus in sacrificing his life for us, and by our response in God's grace, we become the salt of the earth and the light of the world. The purpose of the mass in the sanctification of man and the glorification of God. May we be salt and light to the world.



I want you to close your eyes and think of the greatest saint in history. It's going to be different for everyone. Just think of that person and answer the question: Why is he or she a great saint?

The greatest saints in history were not great at holiness. God brought holiness about within them because (ding ding ding! The Year of St. Francis – Simplicity

Pope Leo proclaimed a special Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi on the occasion of the 800th anniversary of his death. St. Francis reminds us of the timeless value of poverty and simplicity. By renouncing wealth and social prestige, he showed that freedom of heart is born of detachment from material goods. For today's person, living in a world of consumerism, this is an extremely timely invitation to moderation, responsible use of goods, and placing God and neighbor above material possessions: it is a matter of "being" more than "having."

In our time, when faith can be reduced to emotions, this attitude encourages consistency between faith and daily life, and witness given through actions rather than only words or feelings. His life was a response to indifference and selfishness—problems just as evident today.
