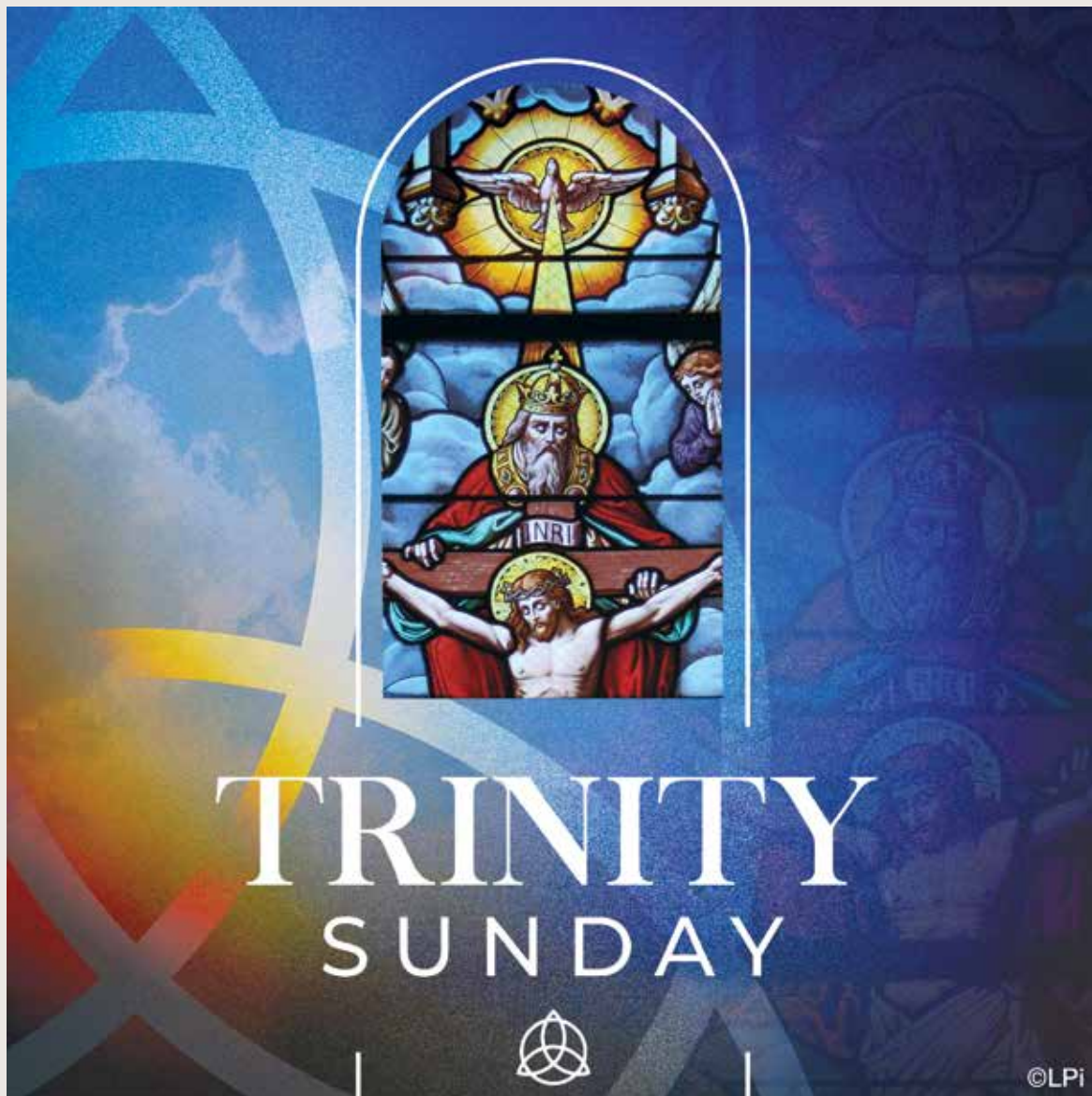

## Today's Readings

### First Reading

God reveals Himself as merciful and faithful; Moses worships and asks forgiveness and God's continued presence with His people.

*Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9*

*The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you. 2 Corinthians 13:13*

Dear Friends,

St. Paul ends his second letter to the Corinthians with what has been called "one of the clearest trinitarian passages in the New Testament" (from commentary on 2 Corinthians in the New American Bible).

The Preface for Trinity Sunday, addressing God the Father, expresses our Trinitarian faith beautifully:

For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit you are one God, one Lord: not in the unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance. For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit, so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance, and their equality in majesty.

This central element of our faith conveys the belief that God, who is love, possesses an interior life of relationship: the love of the Father, the "lover," for the Son, the "beloved," the Son's love for the Father, and the love between them, which is the Holy Spirit. This is a model for our lives as baptized Catholics – to live lives of love,

which is not a "thing" but a relationship between persons.

There is an episode of the Simpsons about Heaven. First, "protestant Heaven" is pictured as people wearing halos and wings, sitting alone on a cloud playing a harp. Then "Catholic heaven" is shown in a series of banquets, where the saints partake of a joyous family celebration involving food and dance and song. It reminds me of the quote from Hilaire Belloc's poem *The Catholic Sun*:

Wherever the Catholic sun doth shine,  
There's laughter and dancing and good red wine.  
At least I've always found it so.

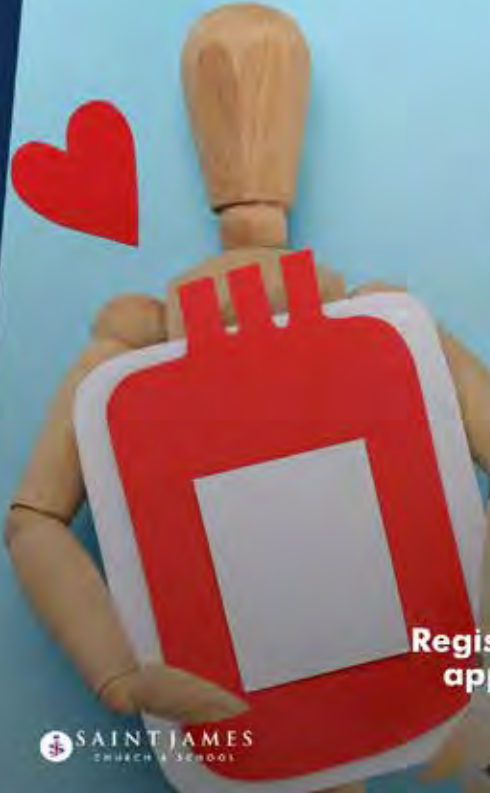

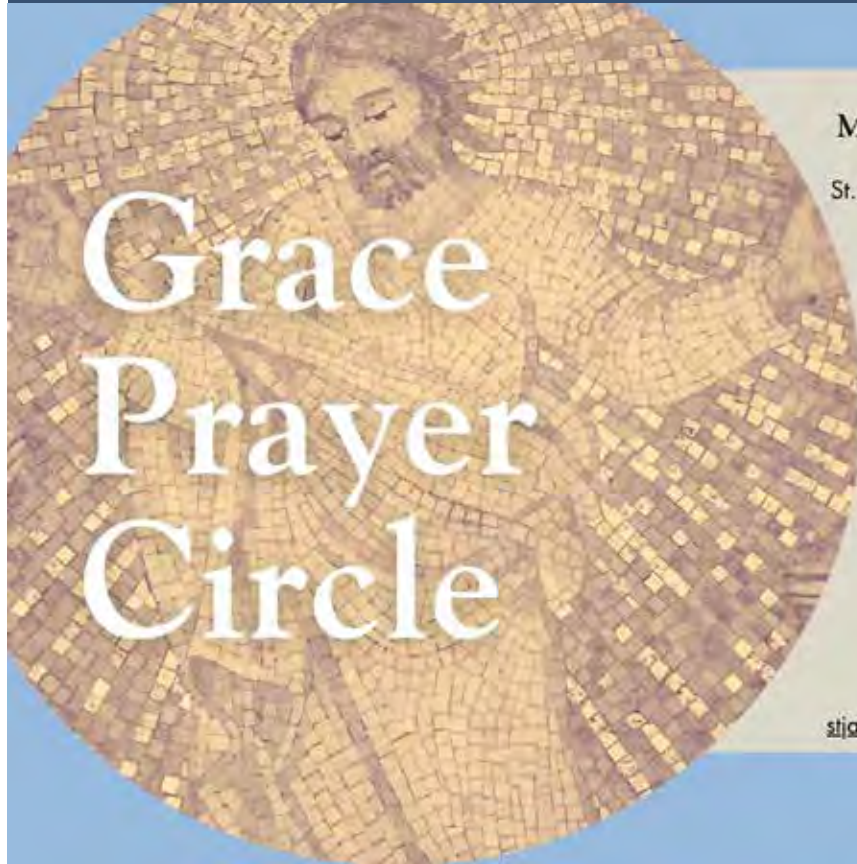

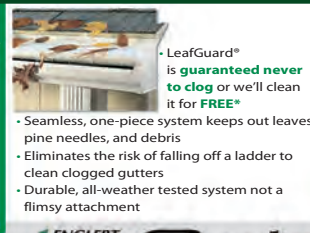
