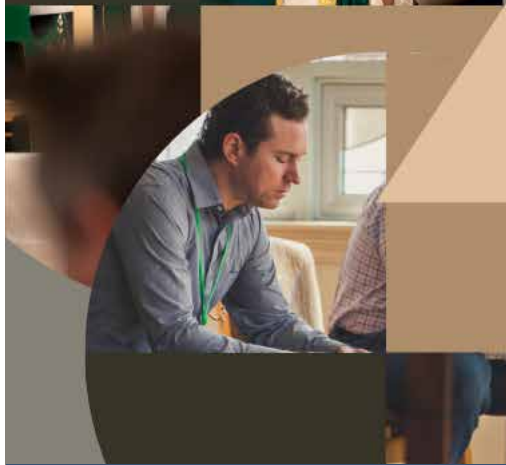

Today's Readings

First Reading

Dear Friends,

As a part of the celebration of the USA's 250th anniversary, the bishops of the United States are consecrating our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The devotion to the Sacred Heart is an ancient practice of the Church. Probably the best known manifestation of this devotion comes to us through St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French Visitation sister who lived in the 17th century.

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received her visions and apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus over an 18-month period, spanning from 1673 to 1675. The visions took place at the Monastery of the Visitation in Paray-le-Monial, France.

The most notable visions occurred on specific dates:

- December 27, 1673: The first major apparition, where Jesus revealed his Sacred Heart and chose her to spread the devotion.
- 1674: Two subsequent apparitions took place in July 1674, emphasizing Christ's desire for the return of love.
- June 16, 1675: The "Great Apparition," during which Jesus asked for the institution of a liturgical feast dedicated to the Sacred Heart.

Jesus showed St. Margaret Mary his flaming heart and told her that he could no longer contain his burning love. He wanted to pour it out on all mankind, and she was to spread this message to the world. The image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a widely popular element of Catholic piety. Today we join the bishops of the U.S. in their consecration.

In his encyclical letter on consecration to the Sacred Heart of 1899, *Annum Sacrum*, Pope Leo XIII wrote:

"He it was who snatched us 'from the power of darkness' (Colossians 1:13), and 'gave Himself for the redemption of all' (1 Timothy 2:6). Therefore not only Catholics, and those who have duly received Christian baptism, but also all men, individually and collectively, have become to Him 'a purchased people' (1 Peter 2:9). St. Augustine's words are therefore to the point when he says: "You ask what price He paid? See what He gave and you will understand how much He paid. The price was the blood of Christ. What could cost so much but the whole world, and all its people? The great price He paid was paid for all."

Laborers

"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few."

This excerpt from Matthew's Gospel has become a catchphrase in the modern Church. We give ourselves vertigo with the amount of head-shaking we do over the much-lamented "decline in numbers."

Which numbers, you ask? Well, take your pick — numbers of baptized Catholic children who continue to profess their faith in adulthood, numbers of registered parishioners, numbers of priests ordained each year. All are a fraction of what they were generations ago.

That last one — the priests — that's a particular worry for us, isn't it? So we pray, "Send us laborers, Lord! Make them holy. Make them earnest."

And then we add, in the silence of our hearts: "Make them perfect."

It's no secret that part of the reason the pews are empty is because we often find it hard to love the Church if we find it hard to love a particular priest, a particular bishop, or a particular human representative of the Church.

Because that's the thing about priests and bishops and all the laborers in the field: they are human. They are sinners. Just like you and me.

We must consider this: today's Gospel lists the Apostles whom Jesus sent out in ministry to heal, console, and evangelize, and right at the end — like a record scratch — comes the name of Judas Iscariot, the betrayer. If ever a laborer failed in his work, it was Judas.

And surely, when he did, his fellow laborers were so demoralized and so disenchanted that they considered laying down their tools and leaving the harvest to wither and die.

But they did not, and we must not.

Without cost we have received, and without cost we are called to give.

So we labor on, for the day is drawing to a close, and the threshing time is near.

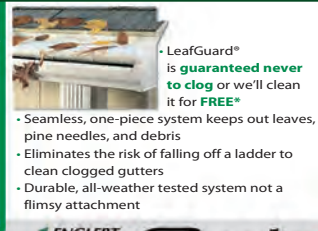
