THE TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Today's Readings

First Reading

God welcomes all who faithfully seek Him, calling them to justice, righteousness, and worship, declaring His house a place of prayer for all nations.

Isaiah 56:1, 6-7

Second Reading

God's promises remain faithful; through mercy, He brings salvation to all, allowing disobedience to reveal His boundless compassion.

Romans 11:13-15, 29-32

Gospel

A Canaanite woman persistently asks Jesus to heal her daughter; her great faith moves Him to grant her request.

Matthew 15:21-28

For God delivered all to disobedience, that he might have mercy upon all.

- Romans 11:32

This final line from the second reading in today's Mass might seem a little confusing. Did God really deliver all to disobedience? A better way to understand it could be that God allowed, by his permissive will, that all the human race suffer the effects of Original Sin, and the whole human race would be offered mercy through God's plan.

The Kerygma refers to the core, foundational message of the Gospel. It is a Greek word meaning "proclamation." The Kerygma can be described in four words: created, captured, rescued, response. Created: God created the world and the human race out of love. Captured: Through sin, Satan captured the human race. Rescued: Through the saving acts of Jesus, God rescued man from sin and restored him to the life of grace. Response: How do we as men and women respond to this great act of love – the Life, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus?

The Kerygma is the heart of our faith. It is essential to keep returning to this proclamation. The mission of the Church is to proclaim what God did through Christ and call people into a relationship of love with God. The final goal of the Church, and of all people, is salvation.

Do you desire to receive this salvation which is the only way to the Father? Are you:

- a baptized Catholic who has not been confirmed?
- a baptized Christian in a non-Catholic communion?
- an unbaptized person in a non-Christian faith?
- A person of no formal faith?

Our OCIA – Order of Christian Initiation of Adults – could be for you. This is a process of learning the Catholic faith leading to receiving the sacraments at Easter. This season we will begin on Tuesday, September 8 at 7:00 pm in the lower level of the church, and meet most Tuesdays until Easter.

Come and See! There is no charge. All materials are provided. If you have any questions, please see me or any of our parish staff. You can also express your interest by visiting the web page below. Sixteen people are expected to start this process next month. There is a place for you too!

PATH TO SUNDAY

August 16, 2026 • 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Was Jesus in a bad mood? In today's Gospel, a Canaanite woman comes to Jesus asking him to heal her daughter. At first, his response seems surprisingly harsh: "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." That sounds pretty tough, doesn't it? But Jesus is not being cruel. He is teaching something much deeper about faith, salvation, and the relationship between Jews and Gentiles.

We sometimes forget something fundamental about our Catholic faith: Jesus was Jewish. So were Mary and Joseph. So were the apostles. In fact, the earliest members of the Church were Jewish. Since we as Catholics speak of Mary being our spiritual mother, we might say that we have a Jewish mother.

Through Mary, Jesus came into the world, and through Jesus, salvation was offered first to the Jewish people and then to all humanity. The Old Testament tells the story of God's covenant with Abraham and his descendants, the people of Israel. God did not abandon that covenant. As St. Paul says, "the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable." The Jewish people therefore remain a people beloved by God. Yet God's plan was always bigger. Through the Jewish people came Mary; through Mary came Jesus; and through Jesus came the New Covenant, extending God's mercy to every nation.

That is what makes the Canaanite woman's encounter with Jesus so important. She was a Gentile, yet she recognized who Jesus was and trusted him completely. Jesus praised her: "O woman, great is your faith!" Her daughter was healed. The message is clear: salvation comes from the Jews, but salvation is for everyone.

As Catholics, there is no room for antisemitism. We should never forget our spiritual roots. Our faith is inseparably connected to the Jewish people and the promises God made to them. Our hope is ultimately for the day when all people will be united in Christ—not through force, but through freely embracing the truth and mercy of God.

Reflection Questions:

- How can the Canaanite woman's faith inspire you to trust Jesus when his response is difficult to understand?
- How does knowing that Jesus, Mary, and the apostles were Jewish shape your understanding of the Jewish people?
- How can you help build greater unity, respect, and understanding among people of different faiths?

Creation Care Corner

Creation Care Benefits of Composting. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), food scraps alone comprise approximately 25% of municipal solid waste in landfills. When yard trimmings and other organic materials are included, these organics are almost half of all the waste in U.S. landfills. Instead of just throwing all this away, consider composting instead. Making compost keeps these materials out of landfills where they take up space and release methane, a potent greenhouse gas. Your compost can then be used to enrich soil and reduce the need for fertilizer. For convenience, try using an airtight receptacle in your kitchen for interim storage of scraps to reduce trips to your outdoor composter. Don't have a yard or garden to use? Check and see if there are community drop-off sites in your city, or commercial pick-up services. More info at www.epa.gov/recycle/composting-home
