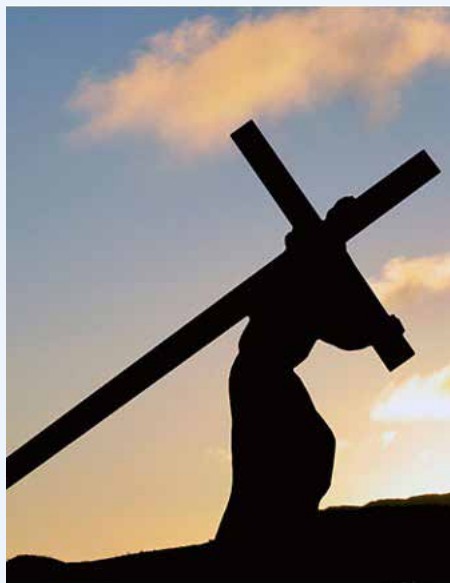
Gospel

Matthew 16:21-27

Dear Friends,

Last week we heard the beautiful words Jesus spoke to Peter: "Blessed are you, Simon, son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church," (Matt 16:18). Immediately following, when Peter attempts to tell Jesus that he must not go to Jerusalem to be killed, he hears what sound like very different words: "Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance (stumbling block) to me; for you are not on the side of God, but of men," (Matt 16:23).



Jesus says these words out of love for Peter. Peter does not yet understand what Jesus has been teaching the Apostles since he first called them. "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses

his life for my sake will find it," (Matt 16:24-25).

Herein lies the great paradox of the Christian life. While our human bodies crave comfort, pleasure, and ease, the Christian faith is demanding. Self-denial, self-sacrifice, deferring to the other, disciplined wills – these are the paths to finding our true selves in Jesus Christ. The great saints knew this, believed it, and lived it. Living in this time of excessive material comfort, this can seem ludicrous, or at least irrelevant. The Beatitudes make no sense and have no appeal to many people who are "of the world."

Jesus said to Pilate as he is being tried in Jerusalem, "My kingdom is not of this world." Christians must make a choice. St. Ignatius of Loyola described the world as being either under the standard of Christ or the standard of Satan. Lord, give us the grace to live in this world while marching under the standard of Christ.
