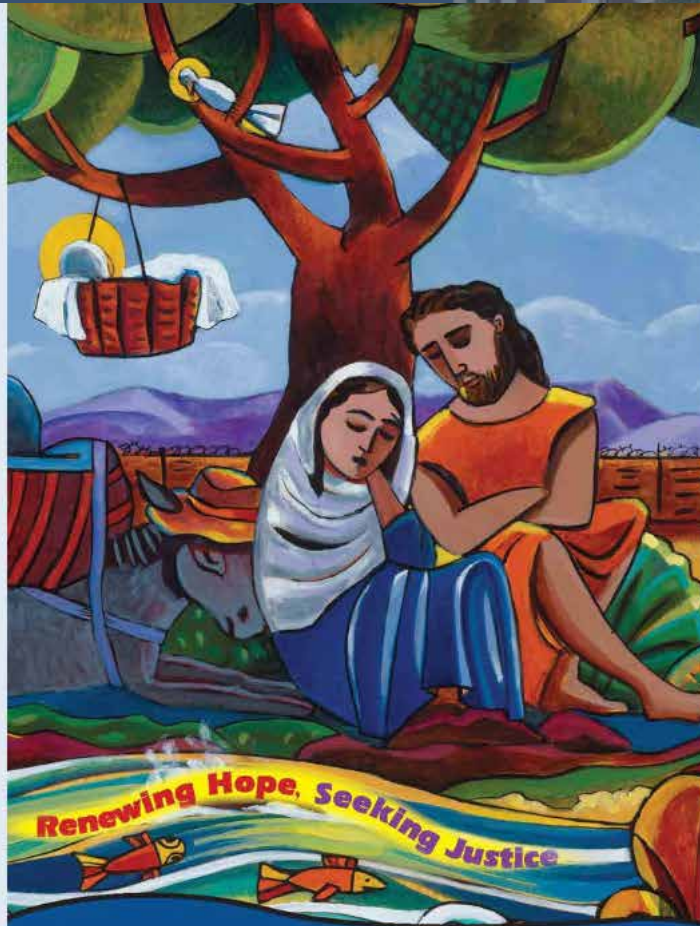

Dear Friends,

Today we are treated to what is called the Philippians Hymn from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians. This powerful passage from Philippians chapter 2 is a part of evening prayer in the breviary every Saturday. The breviary is the prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours which priests and deacons at their Ordination, and religious (sisters, brothers, monks) in their vows promise to pray every day. These prayers fulfill the Scriptural exhortation to pray constantly. These prayers are offered for the people we serve.

The Philippians hymn extols the great humility of Jesus in emptying himself, taking on the Cross for the sake of all of us. It ends with these words:

At the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

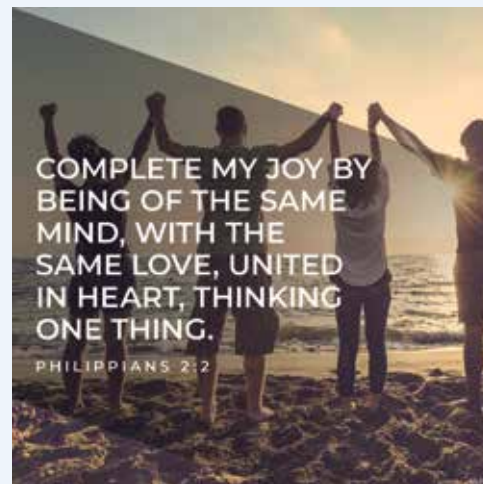
This a beautiful acknowledgment of what Jesus has done for us – his saving act of accepting the penalty of the Cross out of his self-sacrificial love for the human race – and for each one of us. The prophet Isaiah wrote, "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that made us whole, and with his stripes we are healed." Our transgressions, our iniquities, our chastisement – all of this he took for us and offered us healing and new life.

This is what is made present at every mass, right here on our altar. Rightly this is called the sacrifice of the mass. In this sacrifice, in which we participate, our forgiveness and salvation are realized. What a tremendous, gratuitous gift!

Let us approach this magnificent gift of love with gratitude and a holy fear of the Lord. Know that I pray for all of you at every mass. I feel a great communion with you and with the Lord as we celebrate the Eucharist every day.

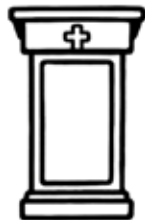
The Parish Youth Choir leads music at most Children's Formation Masses.

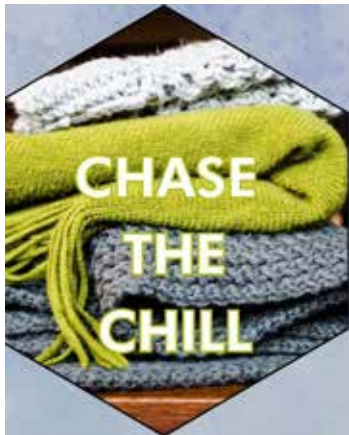

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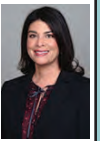

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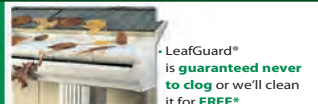
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
